





Use a generic description on assignments

- 1. Click "Submit Assignment" in the upper right corner of the screen.
- 2. To upload a file, click on **Choose File** to select the file from your computer.

OR

To answer using a text box, click on the **Text Entry** tab and answer the questions in the text box.

- 3. Finally, click "Submit Assignment" for it to be graded by the teacher.
 - Remember Quizzes can be self graded
 - Publish vs Unpublish







- Make it interactive or add a quiz!

- 4. Macbook Air (Command + Shift + 5)



EDpuzzle empowers teachers to make any video into a lesson

- Take any video from YouTube, Khan Academy, Learn Zillion, etc.
- Use the full video or just a section
- Voiceover your explanation if desired
- Embed checkpoint questions at any point in the video
- Collects data as students watch and interact with the video
- Works seamlessly with Canvas (show how to link)





Student Progress Report




