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Regulations for Attendance:

1. \$60 fee must be paid and proof of age must be provided to register. This must be done on or before the 1st day of class.
2. Students who receive free and reduce lunch may request a fee reduction that must be completed prior to the 1st day of class.
3. Fee reduction requests must be verified by the student's Notification of Benefits Letter from Duplin County School Food Services.
4. You must be in attendance the first day. Students are allowed just one absence from class. Any other absence may result in removal from the class and you will not be able to take Driver Education through the school system again.
5. You are expected to follow the DCS behavior guidelines and comply with the driver's education teacher's rules. Failure to comply with these guidelines and rules will result in removal from the class. Any student removed for may not be allowed to take Driver Education through the school system again and **no refund** will be given for those students who are removed from class due to failure to attend or for disciplinary action.
6. Students should bring pencils and paper.
7. Students must have their own transportation to and from the school.

During the driver education class we will have someone come in and check the students' vision. If your student wears glasses or contacts please make sure they have them each day during class. If the examiner checks your student's vision and they do not meet the passing requirement, you will be required to be cleared by an optometrist and provide proof to the driver education instructor.



Students who feel they are ready for driver education should certainly be able to conduct themselves in a mature manner while in the classroom. They will show respect and follow rules or they will be asked to leave. There is a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for absences, tardiness, and inappropriate behavior!
