## Accessing the CreationStation<sup>™</sup> Software

If your school or district has purchased the CreationStation software module, you can access it in two ways.

- 1 Click on the Modules tab, and you will go directly to the CreationStation search page, which enables you to search for any title uploaded via CreationStation.
- 2 Or click on the icon on the Dashboard, and you will go to the CreationStation Media Upload screen.

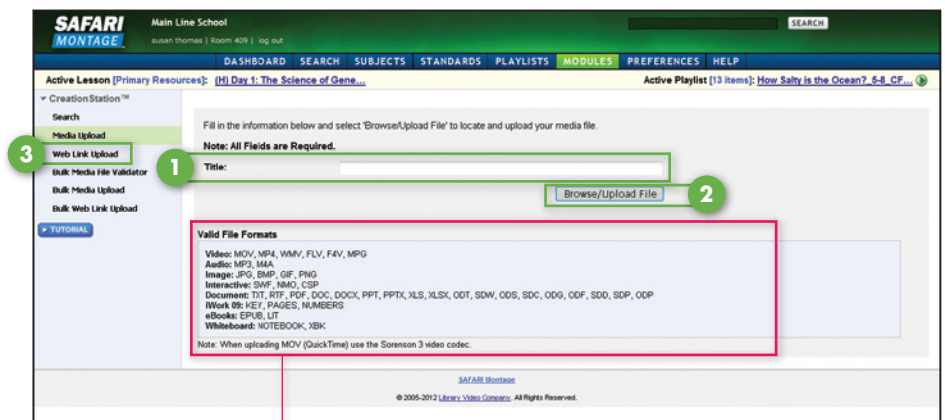


## Uploading Media

To upload media into SAFARI Montage<sup>®</sup> via CreationStation, a user must be in the **Teacher w Upload** or **Administrator** group.

- 1 Enter the title as you would like it to appear on SAFARI Montage.
- 2 Click on Browse/Upload File to find the file you want to upload.
- 3 Or click on Create Web Link Title to upload a web link.

Once the item has been uploaded, you can complete the associated metadata to fully integrate the file into your SAFARI Montage media collection.



In addition to Smart Notebook<sup>™</sup>, SAFARI Montage supports Promethean<sup>®</sup> Flipchart (.flp, .flipchart), Promethean Resource Pack (.as3a), SMART Notebook (.xbk, .notebook), Hitachi<sup>®</sup> StarBoard<sup>®</sup> (.yar) and elInstruction<sup>™</sup> Workspace<sup>™</sup> (.gwb).

# Adding and Editing Metadata

Adding metadata is a critical part of integrating your content into SAFARI Montage, as it enables your media file to be searched, along with all the rest of the content on your SAFARI Montage system. You can add metadata when you upload a title, or return to a title and add metadata at a later time.

**Upload a Teacher's Guide, Blackline Master or an Ancillary Attachment**

Below, you may upload a teacher's guide, blackline master, or an ancillary attachment to associate with your uploaded media, **An Interview with Principal Harris**.

To associate an uploaded file with your media, click "Browse...", then double-click a file on your machine's hard drive or network.

Click the "Add Teacher's Guide," "Add Blackline Master" or "Add Ancillary Attachment" button to upload and associate your attachment to your media content.

To associate a web page with your uploaded media, cut and paste or type in the web page URL into the textbox labeled URL, and then click the "Add Teacher's Guide," "Add Blackline Master" or "Add Ancillary Attachment" button to link your attachment to your media content.

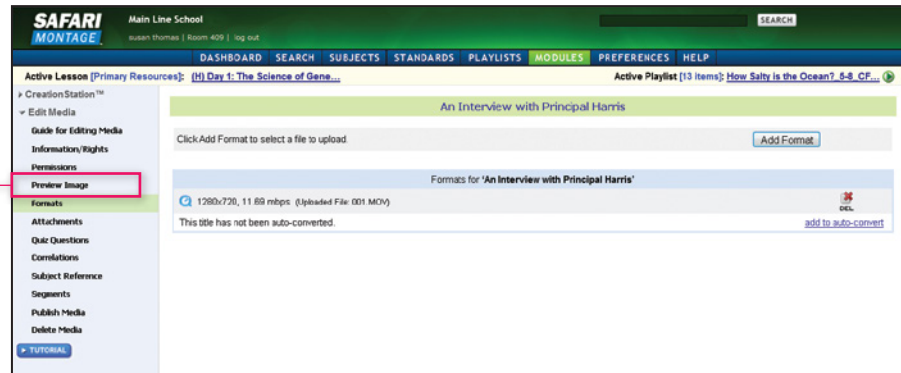
When publishing media, be sure that you have completed all of your metadata first, since you will not be able to edit your content once your file has been sent for approval.

# Formats

When adding a video file to SAFARI Montage via CreationStation, you are given the option of adding additional formats to the same file. For instance, the same video could be added in high and low resolution, for school and home viewing, if your school/district has purchased the Managed Home Access software module.

## TIP

When adding a file to SAFARI Montage via CreationStation, a thumbprint image is generated. You are given the option to select a different image by regenerating the thumbnail, creating a slate, or using a generic or user uploaded image.



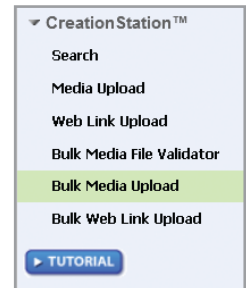
# Segmenting Your Media

SAFARI Montage CreationStation gives you the ability to easily segment your uploaded digital audio and video resources into individual chapters and key concepts. The segments that you create for your uploaded content will appear on your media's title page, just as they do for other media on the SAFARI Montage system.

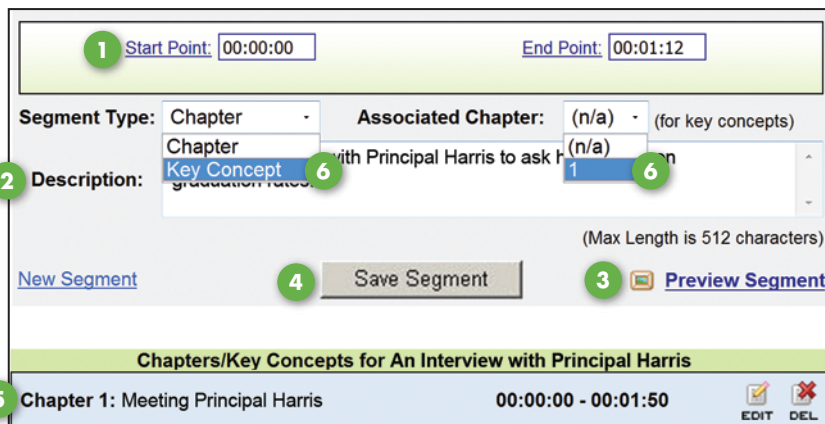
In the 'Edit Media' menu of your title, click on 'Segments.'

- 1 As the video plays, click on the 'Start Point' and 'End Point' boxes to define your chapter segment.
- 2 Include a description of the segment that will appear on your media's title page.
- 3 Click on 'Preview Segment' to play the segment back as you have defined it. You can redefine your start and end points as much as you need to until you are satisfied with your chapter segment.
- 4 Click on 'Save Segment' to create your chapter segment, which will then appear at the bottom of the screen.
- 5 Once you have created chapters, you can further segment your content into key concepts within those chapters.

## TIP



The SAFARI Montage Bulk Upload feature allows you to add multiple pieces of content to the system at one time.



## TIP

A key concept is a subsection of a chapter. When creating a key concept, remember to identify in which chapter it appears.
